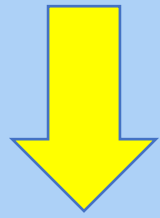


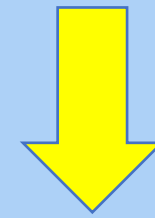


# Self vs Role

- Patient

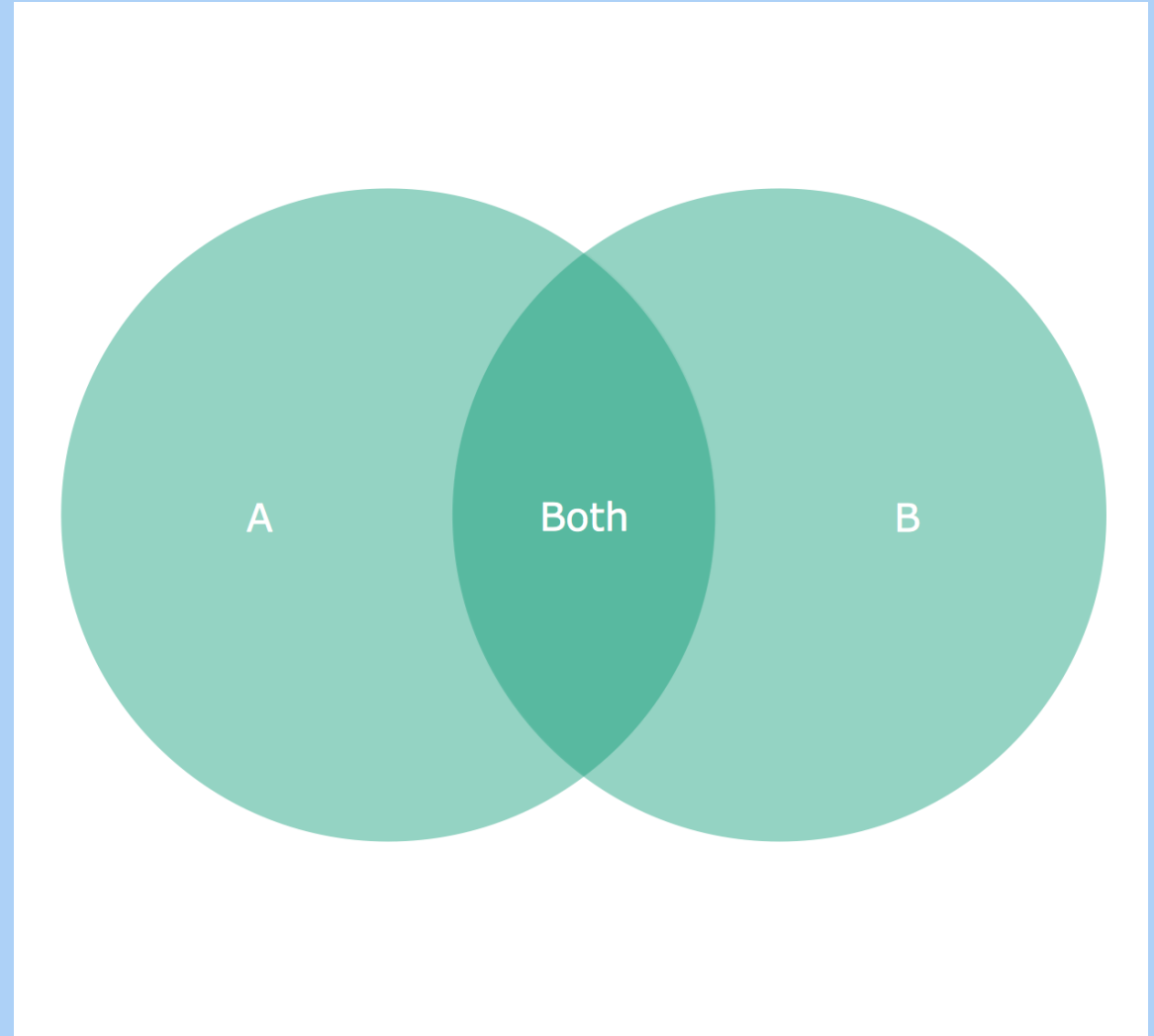
## Role Examples:

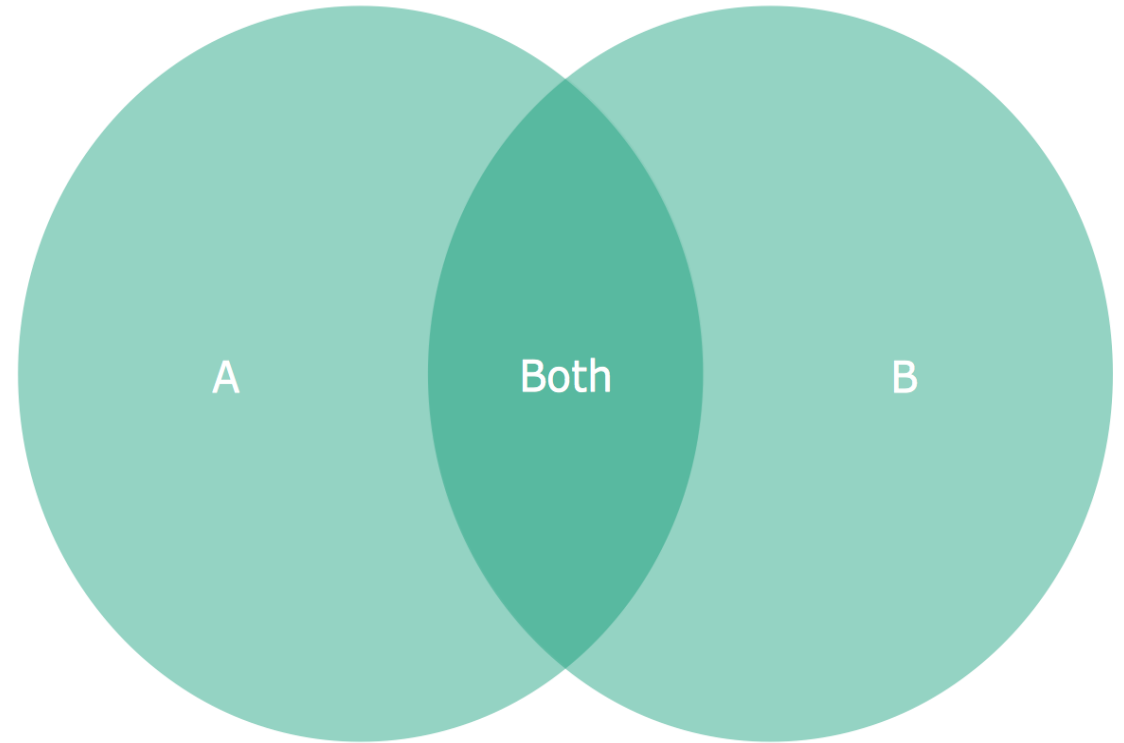
## Self vs Role Discussion

# What Role Do You Play?

## Characteristics of Roles

- Can be hard to change
- The role you become may limit yourself
- The more roles you play, the more factions you're involved with
- Roles can create opportunities for influence

## Formal Roles

- Roles that are typically related to titles and organizational charts
- Represent a static hierarchy

## Informal Roles

- Connection outside of the organizational chart
- Regardless of title, someone can motivate others and others can look up to them

## Separate Self from Role ←

We are not our roles ★

Our roles are tools

- Different Roles are necessary and useful and provide different tools
- Each role is you, but you are not just your role
- Give yourself permission to play different roles authentically
- Think about where you have influence
